We offer a wide range of fiction and books on country life, cookery, travel, biography and other popular subjects, as well as information leaflets. Large print books, audio books and e-books are also available and visits are usually every three weeks.

Don't be afraid to ask

Everyone has times when they need a bit of support. Perhaps you've been ill or are recovering from an operation – or maybe you're just not as mobile as you used to be. We will visit you to talk about how the service works and what you like to read. With support from our volunteers, you don't have to stop doing the things you enjoy or need to do.

You can use the Home Library Service just for a short time, e.g. in the winter. The service is for you if you are a carer too.

All our volunteers are local people who are DBS/PVG* checked and carry photographic ID so you don't need to worry about letting them into your home. They all want to support people and really care about helping you get the most out of life.

That's why they'll be happy to just call in for a chat, drop off some books and check on how you are doing. Our Home Library Service is there to make life a whole lot easier. Sometimes, just the reassurance that you're not on your own is enough.
