Website (Cllr Carey)

The website continues to grow in content and functionality under Cllr Carey's management. However, the implications of meeting the new legislation WCAG2.1 are onerous. Our website **must** comply with these legal requirements for accessibility [and so must any other community site that we host on our website]. These requirements seek to ensure that the information we publish as a parish council on our website, is accessible by all persons, including those with certain handicaps.

Cllr Carey has identified over 1000 changes that need to be made to gain compliance. The CWG will discuss this at our next meeting and make a recommendation to the Council in February.
