

## LOCAL AMENITIES WORKING PARTY REPORT FOR CVPC MEETING ON 12.3.21

### TERMS OF REFERENCE

To work with the Clerk (and other members of CVPC as appropriate) to check, maintain, repair and arrange the replacement of local amenities.

To discuss and consider any desirable amenity improvements for the area, to make a plan and to ask CVPC to consider their conclusions.

Amenities would include benches, bus shelters, fingerposts, footpaths, grit bins, lengthsman's duties, noticeboards, Whitchurch playground, war memorials, trees and verges. Other similar amenities could be added by CVPC.

The more ecological duties of the current Local Environment Working Party will be taken on by the Climate and Ecological Emergency Working Party.

This working party has only just been 'reformed' so there has been no time for a zoom committee meeting before the April Parish Council meeting.

Instead members were asked whether they would like to submit anything for this report. Responses included

1. To tackle the footpaths issue which would involved the appointment of officers for all 3 parishes, definition of their remit and possible need to register any routes currently in limbo.
2. The bench for Goodens Hill has been completed and is being housed temporarily until a suitable site is chosen.
3. One of the noticeboards in Morcombelake has been in need of repair.
4. The survey of the gritbins for the whole parish has been completed except for the allocation of which ones are filled up by the Dorset Council free of charge, and which ones CVPC have to pay for.
